Social growth will be stimulated by regular dorm activities and campus events. 2c. Leadership opportunities (RA, DA) will provide an avenue to grow leadership potential. 2d. Adherence to community standards will encourage students to be prepared for various ministry guidelines.</p> <p>3a. Students will have easy access to educational facilities (library and computer) and residence hall computer networking. 3b. Dedicated study lounges will be set aside for students. 3c. The residence halls will provide a quiet and clean environment in which to study.</p> <p>4a. Nightly patrols of the buildings and grounds by Campus Safety Services will ensure a safe living environment. 4b. Health services will be easily accessible to all students. 4c. The assignment of weekly dorm duties for students and weekly room inspections by the resident life staff will ensure a health living environment.</p>	<p>1a. Bi-Weekly Dorm Meetings are taking place under the leadership of the RAs. Spiritual application is a part of those meetings. 1b. Students are encouraged to do personal Bible Study through their RAs and LIFE Groups; additionally, faculty and staff encourage students in their walk with God through class and personal contact. 1c. As student conflicts have been dealt with, Scripture has been used to help them respond to the issue. 1d. LIFE Groups have been set-up to help with accountability.</p> <p>2a/b. An active schedule of events has been developed by SGA (Student Government Association) and RAC (Resident Affairs Council). Also, students attend the sporting events of the school teams. 2c. Meetings are happening weekly with all the RAs to discuss their roles and opportunities. Bi-weekly meetings happen with each individual RA. DA leadership is being evaluated and developed. 2d. Students are expected to follow the Handbook guidelines; if they are not, discipline and follow-up is taking place.</p> <p>3a. Computer labs are available in Miller Hall, library and Peterson Hall. Network connections is available in their dorm room, library, ODC and Charger Café. 3b. Study lounges have not yet been established. 3c. Quiet hours are enforced by the RAs.</p> <p>4a. Campus Safety makes rounds consistently each night. 4b. Health Services maintains regular office hours and provides information to the students on a regular basis. 4c. RAs assign weekly dorm duties and Student Services Staff do weekly dorm inspections.</p>	<p>1. Continued evaluation of Spiritual growth will take place.
