



Financing your education may seem like an intimidating part of your graduate education, but the LBC Financial Aid team is here to help each step of the way. **It can be as easy as 1, 2, 3.**

1. You are eligible to apply for federal assistance if you are...
  - matriculated into one of the graduate degree programs
  - a U.S. Citizen or a permanent resident of the U.S.
  - not in default on any prior student loans or other federal aid

2. Complete the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) online as soon as possible.

Use LBC's school code: **003285** to send it to LBC.

The FAFSA is used to determine eligibility for all the federal financial aid programs including federal student loan programs. You may complete the FAFSA online at <https://fafsa.ed.gov>.

3. You must apply for financial aid each academic year.

## Scholarships

### Calvary Bible Institute Scholarship

A tuition discount is offered to students who attended Calvary Bible Institute or is a member of Greater Mt. Calvary Holy Church. Application required.

### Church Matching Scholarship

LBC will match up to \$500. Students must complete the church matching scholarship application. Funds from the church must be submitted by August 5 for the fall semester and January 5 for the spring semester.

### Fahler/Johnson Graduate Scholarship

Awarded to students enrolled in a Master of Arts in Ministry program.

### International Student Scholarship

Thirty percent tuition scholarship. Awarded to foreign students. Not applicable to doctoral students.

### Military Discount

Qualified active duty military students will receive a 25% tuition discount on courses. Must submit a copy of most recent Leave and Earnings Statement (LES) to the Financial Aid Office. Not applicable to doctoral students.

### New Antioch Baptist Church Scholarship

A tuition discount is offered to students who are an active member of New Antioch Baptist Church. Application required.

## Other Important Information

### Education Tax Credit

Federal income tax credits may be available to students who qualify. Information can be found online at [www.irs.gov](http://www.irs.gov).

### Academic Progress

Students must maintain satisfactory academic progress in order to receive financial aid. See the Capital Seminary and Graduate School catalog for requirements.

### Federal Refund Policy

Students receiving federal aid who withdraw before 60% of the term has elapsed will be subject to the Federal Refund Policy. LBC will calculate a federal aid refund to determine if financial aid funds must be returned. Contact the financial aid office for further details.



### Perry Graduate Scholarship

Awarded to students enrolled in the Master of Arts in Bible or a Master of Arts in Ministry program.

### Private Scholarships

[www.educationplanner.org](http://www.educationplanner.org) is a free scholarship search engine that matches student's personal and career data to eligible scholarships by scanning a pool of thousands of scholarships nationwide.

### Project Bridges Scholarship

This is a tuition scholarship to students whose church is a member of Project Bridges. Students receiving this scholarship are ineligible for the Church Matching Scholarship. Application required.

## Loans

### Federal Unsubsidized Direct Loan

Principal is deferred. The borrower is responsible for interest that accrues while in school. Students may borrow up to \$20,500 if need permits. Apply at <https://studentloans.gov>.

### Federal Direct PLUS Loan for Graduate Students

This is an additional loan if more funds are necessary after borrowing with the Unsubsidized Direct Loan Program. Students must be credit-worthy. For more information go to <https://studentloans.gov>.

## Additional Sources of Aid

### Graduate Assistant and Teaching Assistant

The Graduate Assistant (GA) will assist in his/her academic program department while the Teaching Assistant (TA) will assist a professor in teaching an undergraduate course. Contact your program director for more information.

### PhD Research Assistant (RA)

The RA will assist in his or her academic program department. Contact your PhD program director for more information.

### Veterans Benefits

## Payment Options
