for Undergraduate, Seminary/Graduate, and Doctoral Degrees

A tuition scholarship is available to Lancaster Bible College and Capital Seminary & Graduate students if their church and/or organization is a member of Project Bridges. To apply for this tuition scholarship, students must complete the form once each academic year and have it submitted to the Financial Aid Office at least two weeks prior to the start of their first class. **The academic year is July 1 – June 30.** Scholarships are not retroactive.

Guidelines:

1. In order to participate, the student must be a member in good standing at a church or an organization that is a current member of Project Bridges.
2. Completion of this form does not guarantee admission to Lancaster Bible College | Capital Seminary & Graduate School. Applicants must complete the regular admissions process and be accepted as a student. For more information about the admissions process, go to our website: www.lbc.edu
3. Eligible students must comply with all rules, regulations, policies and standards of LBC | Capital and must maintain satisfactory academic progress according to program guidelines. If the academic standard is not met, the student will not be eligible until his/her GPA meets the minimum requirements.
4. Acceptance of this tuition scholarship may reduce the amount of or make a student ineligible for other forms of financial aid from LBC | Capital. Eligible applicants may apply and receive federal and/or state financial aid in accordance with applicable regulations and guidelines.
5. Please note: Failure to complete forms in their entirety or to follow procedures listed below may result in a delay in processing forms.

Scholarship Amounts

Traditional Undergraduate Students are guaranteed to receive LBC scholarships that will cover at least 25% of annual tuition.

1. Adult Education Undergraduate Students – 25% tuition scholarship
2. Graduate/Seminary Students – 25% tuition scholarship
3. Doctoral Students (PhD and DMin) – 10% tuition scholarship

Procedures:

1. Student/applicant must complete and sign Section 1 of the form and then submit the application to his/her church or organization.
2. Church/organization must complete and sign Section 2 of the form and then send to Project Bridges via fax at 301.262.0305 or scan to info@projectbridges.org.
3. Project Bridges will complete and sign Section 3 of the form and send to LBC's Financial Aid Office. Project Bridges will send student/applicant an email confirming that the application has been completed.
